Chile initiates a campaign with the aim of forbidding the use of antibiotics in aquaculture

In Chile, an international campaign banning the use of antibiotics in aquaculture has been launched. The aim is to align all sanitary standards regarding antibiotics for Chilean salmon with those of rules of the EU and FDA of the US.

Furthermore, it is demanded that the Chilean salmon farmers are to provide free access to historic information on imports and use of antibiotics.

The developments in Chile seem to be just another step towards a worldwide consensus on whether to use antibiotics in aquaculture. These regional and worldwide trends increasingly support a universal ban on the use of antibiotics in aquaculture.
